**3/7-Early Dismissal at 11:55.* Send lunch with your child or pick up a grab n go bag in the cafeteria.

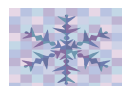
**3/25-27-No school, Pre-registered care available.* Registration with payment due 3/1.

NEW SIGN IN/OUT PROCEDURES



- Sign in/out will take place in the cafeteria. Please ring the buzzer. Please wait patiently for a staff member to buzz you into the building.
- Head into the cafeteria and a staff member will guide you through the sign in/out process.
- When picking up your child, please have a photo ID with you.



SNOW DAYS

If Bridle Path is closed due to inclement weather, the Extended School Care Program is closed.

If Bridle Path has a delayed opening, the Program will open at 8:00 AM for one hour, 9:00 AM for two hours, or 10:00 AM for three hours.

If Bridle Path closes early due to inclement weather, the Extended School Care Program closes two hours after dismissal time. You will receive a call via the school messenger system to inform you that we will close two hours after dismissal.



Weather permitting, we plan on going outside. Please make sure your children are dressed for outside play.

If Group 1 is outside, we will post a yellow flag from the column closest to the cafeteria, in front of the school entrance.

If Group 2 is out on the playground, we will post a purple flag.

If both flags are on the column, nobody is inside to answer the door. You may drive to the Taylor Rd side parking lot to pick up your child. Please walk down to the end of the sidewalk. A staff member will bring your child to you.
